Draft FY 14-15 Planning Work Program

Josh King explained that the staff produces this every year to show balance of activities, Madison County has a project, and community input still needed.

- Transylvania park and ride: research ways to better connect
- Freight across Appalachia: freight issues of manufacturers and logistic providers and some of the issues
- Seniors and coordinated planning
- SPOT development continue to refine areawide CTP to ensure trans projects don't end at the boundary line
- 114,000 80% by DOT and 20 by local dues

Brownie motioned to approve the draft Planning Work Program, Charlie Landreth seconded, all were in favor, and the motion carried.

B. Transportation Planning Branch Updates: Pam Cook reported that the TDM model is moving along on schedule; one month new person in Linh Nguyen's position

C. Legislative Updates: Paul Black informed the group that the Joint Oversight committee met on February 7 and nothing major to affect the west and has packet to share if interested.

Holly Jones asked if any indication of revenue generating options?

Paul Black replied "No, but Bud put out call to give examples of what would happen if funds empty in November and which projects would get stalled if trust fund goes broke."

Board of transportation has study committee and MPOs to take a position and work with metro mayors; Holly Jones asked what they are proposing, and Paul Black replied that there is no money and EPA moving Tier III rules for efficient cars, and that public private partnerships are an option.

Item 4b: LOSRPO Remaining Points to Assign

LOSRPO received 1100 points to assign to Division Needs Projects and 1100 points to assign to Regional Impact projects. LOSRPO only had 8 projects in the Regional Impact tier. One project, H141279, located in Haywood County is geographically split between LOSRPO (79%) and FBRMPO (21%). After assigning the RPO maximum points 79, we have 21 points left over. Transylvania County and Brevard chose not to assign points to the Brevard Bypass, H090183 as they do not support the alignment of this project as presented.
