**Adult Care Homes** (includes Rest Homes) – *Licensed group homes; provide meals;* 24-hour staff to help with activities of daily living; nurses are not required

**Group Homes** (for developmentally disabled adults) – *Licensed homes for 2 to 9 persons* 

**Multi-Unit Assisted Housing** (with services) – *Licensed group housing with one meal and housekeeping service* 

Family Care Homes - Licensed homes for up to 6 residents; nurse not required

**Nursing Homes** – Provide skilled care for individuals who are chronically ill or who are recuperating from illness or injury; regular nursing care provided

**Retirement Centers** – Continuum Care Retirement Center (CCRC) - *Provide continuum of housing and care options*
